



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Slide the 4 way connector on to existing upriser. (use larger hole in the center of the 4 way connector)
- 2. Position 4 way connector at desired height for curtain rod. Cut non-threaded end of wall support rod to desired length equal to the distance between the wall and the upriser tube. Mount the flange on the wall using the mounting hardware and screw the support rod into the flange.
- 3. Next, fit the support rod into the back side of the 4 way connector and tighten set screw.
- 4. Attach both ends of the curtail rod into the opposing sides of the 4 way connector and tighten set screws.
- 5. Before connecting ceiling mount T-connector in far end of curtain rod, be sure to slide the bracket for the 2nd ceiling mount onto the curtain rod. Make sure to place curtain in desired position before closing off the curtain rod. Next, connect both ends of the curtain rod to the ceiling mount T-connector and tighten set screws.
- 6. Finally cut both Ceiling mount rods to correct length. Mount the ceiling flanges in desired position and screw threaded end of the mounting rods into each flange. Position Curtain rod properly and raise the curtain rod up until the brackets fit onto the mounting rods, and tighten the set screws. (Tighten the opposing end to the wall first so that the weight will be supported when switching to the side mount)




